- Graduate study only, must be outside of home country and focused in one of Rotary's seven areas of focus:
  - Peace and conflict prevention/resolution
  - Disease prevention and treatment
  - Water and sanitation
  - Maternal and child health
  - Basic education and literacy
  - Economic and community development
  - Supporting the environment
- University selection, study program and budget required on application
- Rotarians, spouses & lineal descendants (children, grandchildren) of Rotarians ineligible
- Ideal candidates should have good academic performance, public speaking or interpersonal communication skills, high ethical standards in personal/academic/professional life, evidence of civic engagement or commitment, language proficiency as needed for country chosen, and knowledge of state, regional, national and international events, of Rotary and The Rotary Foundation
