



Rotary Global Grant Scholarships for Graduate Study Abroad

Applications are now being accepted for Rotary global grant scholarships for graduate studies abroad for the 2019-20 academic year. Rotary global grants support scholarships for graduate students studying abroad in one of six areas of focus. Scholarships range from one to four years and therefore can include an entire degree program. Prospective scholars must be admitted to the chosen university. The applicant may be a current student or professional seeking graduate studies abroad.

The Rotary Club of Baton Rouge participates in the Rotary District 6200 program offering the global grant scholarships. One award will be made on the district level for studies next year. The club's deadline for applications is Oct. 22, 2018, although we strongly encourage applications to be submitted sooner. The club will screen and help prepare applicants in time for the Rotary district's submission deadline of Nov. 2, 2018. The award for this round is \$30,000. Contact us for an application.

- The applicant's previous academic or work experience in the related fields.
- Strong character and leadership qualities.
- The applicant's career plans as they relate to one of the fields of focus.
